WING COOK-OFF RULES & REGULATIONS

ENTRY FEE: \$40.00

1. COOK-OFF CATEGORY

Wings – Any Way. You may enter more than one type of wings but each entry will require a separate entry form and fee.

2. INGREDIENTS & PREPARATION

In order to ensure the wings are all the same, it is required that teams pick up their wings from the Elbon Shrine Club stand set up at Duda Park the morning of the event. There will be no charge to the teams for the wings. Each team will be required to prepare approximately 15lbs(this may change depending on how many entry's) of wings for competition and sale.

*This is a traditional cook-off competition and everything must be cooked on-site during the hours of the contest. Chicken wings must be cooked from the raw state. Any pre-cooked items will result in disqualification. Pre-Made marinades are allowed. Any seasoning or ingredient necessary to create unique taste is acceptable.

3. COOKING

Each team is expected to maintain as clean and sanitary conditions as possible and to keep wings chilled and fresh before cooking and hot after cooking. Teams must bring their own tables, chairs, cooking utensils, cooking equipment, chafing dishes, cooler with ice, paper towels, booth setup and display items and all other necessary equipment. Teams may erect a canopy or tent. Please use your grill, deep fat fryer, or propane turkey fryer as electricity or generators are not allowed.

4. SELLING

Wings must be ready for sale at set time that will be given that day. Cookers will be given about 3 ¹/₂ - 4hours to cook 15lb of wings. Wing tickets will be sold for \$0.60 each or 10 for \$5 by the Elbon Shrine Club Members with the proceeds (after expenses) going to the Elbon Shrine Club. One ticket will purchase one wing.

5. JUDGING

The winner will be selected by a panel of judges. The judging will be anonymous with evaluations made of each team sometime during the cook-off. Judging will be based on taste, appearance and originality, (all wings must be fully cooked). Contestants will be advised when awards will be presented. 6. PRIZES

Cash prizes — First Place and Trophy (40% entry fees), Second Place (25% entry fees) & Third Place (15% entry fees) — will be presented to the winners.

7. REGISTRATION

Upon arrival at the cooking site, the team captain must check in with Elbon Shrine Club representatives for their area assignment. At that time we will provide you with any new or additional information concerning the cook-off.

8. BOOTH SET-UP

Booth spaces will be 10'x10'. It is strongly recommended each team have a 10' x 10' tent for the day of the event. Set-up of cooking area must take place by 11:30a.m. on Saturday, June 13th, 2015 at Elm and Main St or in parking lot close to Duda Park. One member of each participating team must join us for a brief orientation meeting. Public cook-off displays and demonstrations are encouraged in order to involve the crowd, however; decorating of your booth space is not mandatory. Please call ahead and let us know if you will be bringing in a large cooker as we may want you in early to drop off the cooker and remove vehicle from cooking area.

9. BOOTH TEARDOWN

Areas must be cleaned up at the end of the event. All equipment must be off the premises by 9:00 pm. The City of Staunton and Elbon Shrine Club appreciate your help in keeping the event site clean. Please clean up any trash that is within your booth space and take all garbage to the available collection area. EACH PARTICPANT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR GREASE DISPOSAL. NO GREASE WILL BE ALLOWED IN TRASH CANS OR DUMPSTERS.

10. APPLICATION & FEESCook-off entry form and entry fee of \$40.00 must be received by Friday, May 29th,
